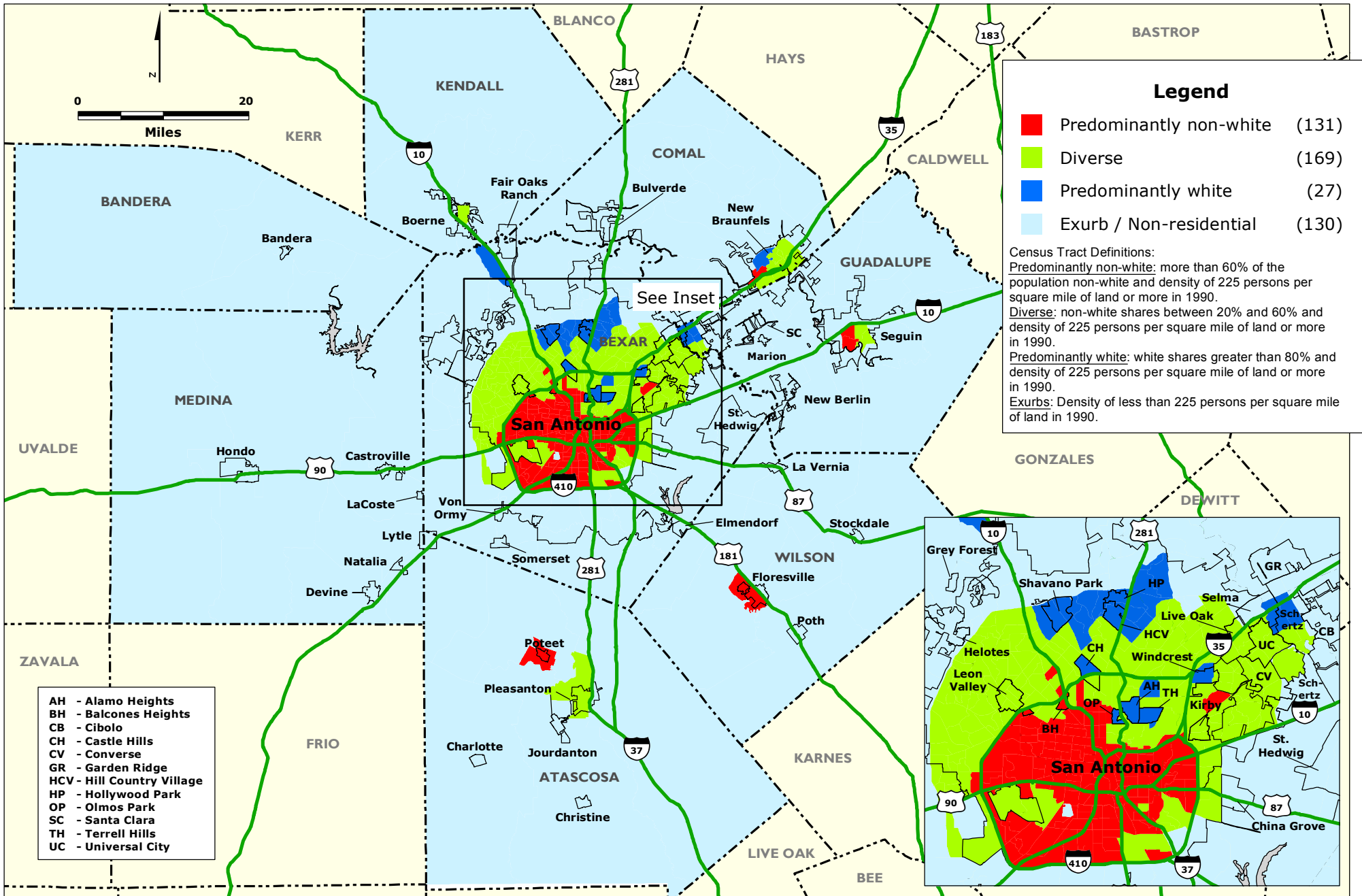


# SAN ANTONIO REGION: Community Type by Census Tract, 1990

Census Tract Definitions:  
 Predominantly non-white: more than 60% of the population non-white and density of 225 persons per square mile of land or more in 1990.  
 Diverse: non-white shares between 20% and 60% and density of 225 persons per square mile of land or more in 1990.  
 Predominantly white: white shares greater than 80% and density of 225 persons per square mile of land or more in 1990.  
 Exurbs: Density of less than 225 persons per square mile of land in 1990.
