### WHO WE ARE:

The Ronald M. Mankoff Tax Clinic has provided free legal assistance for low-income taxpayers since 1981. Through a federal grant and by engaging student attorneys under the supervision of an experienced tax lawyer, we are able to provide completely free legal assistance and representation to those who qualify. Our services include confidential tax consultation, representation before the IRS and Minnesota Department of Revenue, and litigating in the U.S. Tax Court and Federal District Court.

### DO YOU QUALIFY?

If you have a letter from the IRS or have an active controversy with the IRS, we may be able to assist you. Please note that under the terms of our federal grant we generally cannot provide full representation (but may be able to provide a consultation) for individuals and families that are over 250% of the federal poverty line.
